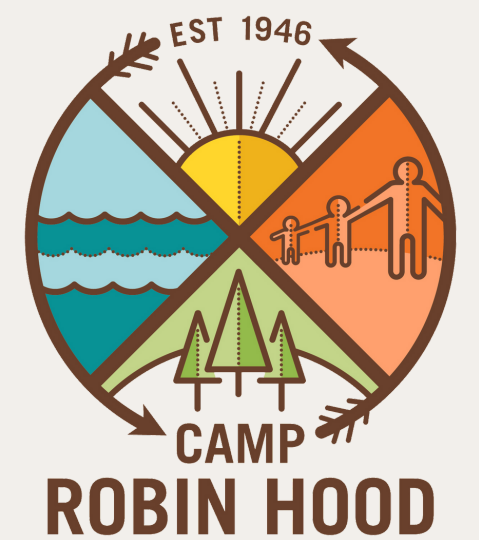

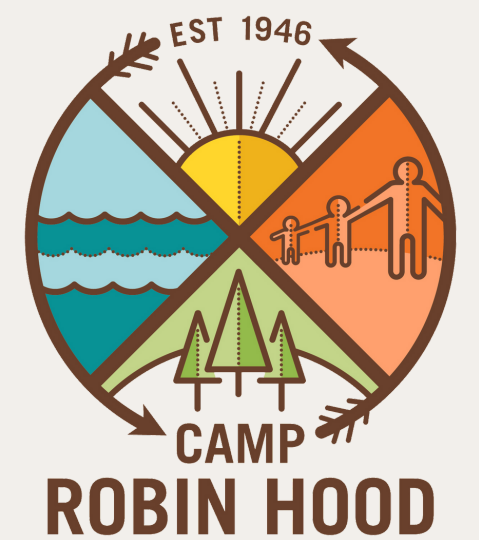

JOB DESCRIPTION



GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend camp daily (including morning meeting), as well as pre-camp events and staff meetings.
- Maintain constant communication with Division Head and work collaboratively with fellow senior staff.
- Review camper profiles, share camper information with staff and ensure counsellors understand and support individual camper needs.
- Follow through on parent concerns; consult with division heads. Daily review of cabin issues and follow-up on any pressing issues or trends.
- Train, evaluate, supervise and support the performance of cabin counsellors.
- Communicate effectively with campers, staff and families.
- Assist, participate and check-in with cabins whenever possible.
- Support implementation of cabin-led activities, including age-appropriate unit-wide and rainy day programming as necessary.
- Complete assigned administrative duties (i.e. attendance, area reports, staff evaluations, etc...).
- Liaise with other members of the senior staff team as necessary.

IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: DIVISION HEAD

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend camp daily (including morning meeting), as well as pre-camp events and staff meetings.
- Maintain constant communication with Program Director and work collaboratively with fellow senior staff.
- Plan and support implementation of activities for your given pod of activities.
- Plan for adaptations of activities for different age groups and camper needs.
- Assist, participate and check-in on specialties whenever possible.
- Train, evaluate, supervise and support the performance of activity counsellors.
- Coordinate with Program Director to ensure necessary inventory of materials for supplies.
- Implement and support routines for activities to maintain cleanliness and organization.
- Complete assigned administrative duties (i.e. area reports, inventory, staff evaluations, etc...).
- Support implementation of rainy day and special event programming as necessary.
- Liaise with other members of the senior staff team (i.e. unit heads, camper relations, special events co-ordinators, etc...) as necessary.
